A long-time resident of Chula Vista, Becky is married to John Moot and together they have 6 grown sons and 7 grandchildren.



June 8, 2020: **Inaugural Golf Tournament**

This fundraising event benefits CVPD's internationally-acclaimed Drone as a First Responder (DFR) program, with the goal expanding drone/aerial support coverage eastern Chula Vista. CVPD's DFR program currently operates two launch sites which provide coverage to about 33% of the city. The department intends to expand the program to a total of six sites to give 100% coverage for 7 days a week. DFR is the most impactful policing paradigm shift in modern policing with over 1,300 flights resulting in over 200 arrests and is a proven way to improve public safety.

The golf tournament will be held at the private and most prestigious San Diego Country Club. Make sure to register very soon, as this event will sell out! Sponsorship levels start at \$10,000, \$7,000, \$6,000, \$4,000 and \$2,500. Foursome is \$2,000 and individual \$500. Dinner only is \$165.
